

# **PROTOCOL: COVID-19 CONDUCT OF ACTIVITY**

## **HIGHLAND PARK LAWN BOWLING CLUB**

439 Golden Avenue Ottawa, ON., K2A 2E7

The Highland Park Lawn Bowling Club (HPLBC) is privately owned and is a member of the Ontario Lawn Bowling Association, District 16, with grounds measuring 210' x 130' - including eight, five metre wide rinks.

Bowling activities will be restricted to practice until such time regulations are relaxed and gathering size is increased.

A survey of HPLBC members indicates a strong desire to be on the green.

Members' preferences for playing times were noted during the survey and will be pre-scheduled accordingly.

Having received a framework from the Ontario Lawn Bowling Association and from Bowls Canada Boulingrin (BCB) Administration, the HPLBC Protocol: Conduct of Activity will be:

### **Prescreening**

- Members will be provided with links to provincial and federal sites on COVID-19 self-assessment, symptoms of COVID-19, and Government of Canada document on disinfecting.
- Members will maintain required social distancing at all times.
- Members will be required to sign Declaration of Compliance and Waivers forms.
- Members will be required to record their name, rink number and date for tracking purposes.
- Each session of activity will have an authorized individual to oversee compliance.

### **Bowls activity**

- Activity on alternate rinks will help to ensure required social distancing.
- Bowlers will bring their own water.
- Members who rent bowls will keep the same bowls for the season.
- Bowls will be sanitized on issuance.
- Bowlers will not loiter on the green.
- Schedules will allow sufficient turn around to avoid overlapping.
- Rakes, mats, and groundsheets will not be permitted.
- Two jacks will be required and will be sanitized after each session.
- Visitors will not be allowed.

### **Operations**

- The main clubhouse will be closed to all except authorized members and of necessity
- One toilet area will be accessible without entering the main clubhouse and will be sanitized after each use. Queuing for the toilet will be outdoors, maintaining social distancing.
- Signage on hygiene and physical distancing will be posted appropriately.
- Sanitizing products will be provided at entrances, doors, sinks and rinks.
- Disinfecting product waste will be binned in plastic-lined wastebins.

Please note that this Protocol applies to the COVID-19 situation, as of June 7, 2020 and will be changed as required.
